1. Introduction

Article 41 of Constitution of India enshrines States with responsibility to provide public assistance to its citizens in case of unemployment, old age, sickness and disablement and in other cases of undeserved want within the limit of its economic capacity and development.

National Social Assistance programme (NSAP) which came into effect from 15th August, 1995. It is an indicatively organised programme to address this concern of all those living in below poverty line. NSAP is thus a 100 percent centrally sponsored Programme of Government of India. It provides financial assistance in the form of social pensions to destitute who are classified as elderly, widows and persons with disabilities who have no regular source of income, either from their own or even from any other family members.

NSAP represents a significant step towards the fulfilment of the Directive Principles in Article 41 of the Constitution. The programme introduced a National Policy for Social Assistance for the poor and aims at ensuring minimum national standard for social assistance in addition to the benefits that states are currently providing or might provide in future. NSAP at present comprises of Indira Gandhi National Old
