#### A BRIEF INTRODUCTION:

The International Centre for Cultural Studies was set up in May 1995 in NAGPUR to facilitate and undertake research on ancient traditions and cultures around the world by Indian and International scholars. The idea was well received by the academicians to be the focal point of cultural renaissance in modern Bharat (India).

Late Prof. Dr. S W Bakhle, former Head of Department of Philosophy, RTM Nagpur University and team of scholars lead the centre from 1998 onwards.

The ICCS provides platform for the scholars to pursue their research in the fields of ancient and modern history, sociology, anthropology, philosophy, religion, archaeology, language, fine arts, folk media, science and other related fields. The ICCS coordinates communication among scholars of ancient traditions all over the world. It is also working with likeminded organisations to foster collaborative efforts that draw indigenous knowledge. Noted scholars, Cultural Ambassadors, Social and Cultural leaders from different parts of world are invited by ICCS to interact. The ICCS organises conferences, seminars, workshops, orientation courses and publishes research works, journals and also conducts lecture series to facilitate the fulfillment of its objectives.

Today ICCS has established relations with World Congress of Ethnic Religions (WCER) of Europe, with Maoris of New Zealand, with Mayans, Aztecs and Native Americans. The ICCS has started its parallel centre in USA under the leadership of Dr. R. S. Dwivedi. Presently Dr. Shekhar Patel is the president of ICCS USA Similar Centers are working in different parts of the world and organising Conferences and Lectures. ICCS Nagpur is led by Dr. V. S. Deshpande as President and Dr. M. S. Kashikar as Secretary.

In 2013 ICCS had interaction with office bearers of Hindu University of America & HUA offered ICCS to start UG course on Indian Traditions & Cultural Heritage which will be in collaboration with HUA. The student participants will be from USA, Europe, & other continents.

# INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES:

ICCS floated a forum called "World Council of Elders of Ancient Traditions and Cultures (WCEATC) to provide a common platform to the various individuals, groups and communities practicing ancient traditions and cultures world over. Under this forum the ICCS organizes triennial global conferences called "SanskritiSangam".

The 1st International conference was held at Mumbai from 4th to 9th February 2003 with the theme 'Mitakuye Oyasin' meaning "We are all related" (A Native American saying). The conference was attended by 167 delegates from all over the world.

The 2nd International gathering saw increased participation of 257 delegates from 42 countries at Jaipur from 5th to 10th February, 2006 with the theme "Spirituality beyond Religions".

The 3rd International Conference was organised at Nagpur from January 31st to February 5th, 2009 which was centered on the theme of "Renaissance of Ancient Traditions and Cultures: Challenges and Solutions". This conference witnessed participation of over 350 delegates from 32 countries representing 25 ancient traditions and cultures across the globe.

The 4th World Conference and Gathering of elders was organised at Haridwar from March 4 to March 7, 2012 in association with Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya. Over three hundred delegates, representing 38 countries and 50 ancient traditions and cultures participated in the conference. It was centered on the theme, "Nourishing the Balance of the Universe".

The 5th International conference was held at Mysore from 31st January to 5th February 2015. on the theme "Universal Wellbeing: Sustaining, Nature, Culture and Communities". Representatives of 55 traditions from about 40 Countries participated.

The 6th International conference was held at Mumbai on 1st February to 4th February 2018. With theme "Exploring Divinity Through Feminine in Ancient Cultures". Representatives of Various traditions from all over the world participated.

#### NATIONAL CONFERENCES:

The ICCS also regularly holds national level conferences at different locations on various relevant themes. The Themes of major conferences organised so far include: 1) Afro-Hindu Cultural Similarities 2) Global Cultural-viability &desirability 3) Decolonizing the Mind 4) Indo-Native American Cultural Similarities 5) Role & Place of Culture in 21st Century 6) Cultures of South Asia & Pacific Region

Memorial Lecture Series every year on "Understanding Cultures and Cultural Cooperation". Eminent Scholars have been invited to present their thoughts on this subject. ICCS also organise lectures and presentations for students in various colleges and institutions.

ICCS is in the process of establishing Diploma and Degree course in "Bharateeya Sanskruti (Indian Culture)". This course aims at providing basic information about various dimensions of Indian Culture. The course will be participatory in nature. ICCS and Hindu University of America have signed MoU in this regard.

RESEARCH FACILITIES & FELLOWSHIPS: ICCS awards fellowships to scholars to conduct research in culture, religion, polity, etc. ICCS organises study tours for Indian and International scholars and students for visiting religious and cultural places in India and abroad. LIBRARY: The ICCS has a well equipped library of its own with nearly 3000 rare books on different cultures of the world such as African, Native American and Asian. All modern networking facilities like computers, scanners, internet connection, audio-visual equipment's are made available for interactions and presentations. ICCS Centre is well furnished with lecture hall, meeting room, guest room, pantry etc.

ICCS has so far published number of scholarly books on topics related to ancient cultures traditions and religious philosophies.

# INTRODUCTION TO CONFERENCE THEME



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
