



- Words limit 1500-2500 words.
- The research papers to be submitted original, unpublished or not under consideration for publication elsewhere. As per standard norms 10 % Plagiarism will be allowed.
- Paper to be prepared in MS-WORD, font Times New Roman, size 12pt, double spaced lines with margin of 1.5on all the sides of A4 size paper.
- The Paper should begin with a relevant title typed in bold uppercase letters followed by author(s) name(s) and address(es)in bold sentence case letters followed by E-mail ID of the corresponding author to be included in a separate line below the address.
