Narayana Murthy, Muhammad Yunus, Omar Abdullah, Shabana Azmi, Subramanian Swamy, Lobsang Sangay, Ustad Zakir Hussain, Swaminathan Gurumurthy etc. in addition to these several eminent personalities like Aung San Suu Kyi, Irina Bokova, Malala Yousafzai, Sunita Williams etc., addressed the Conclave through pre-recorded video message.

During the seventh Indian Youth Parliament to be held during 17-19 January, 2017, deliberations will take place on a number of important subjects like (i) Freedom of Expression : How much is too much? (ii) Colonial Mindset : a Rich Heritage or a Curse ? (iii) Reservation on Caste : Social Justice or Total Injustice? (iv) Repositioning India : A Global Perspective (v) Black Money & Elections : Who will bell the Cat? (vi) Multinational Corporations : Saviors or Saboteurs? etc. A number of eminent speakers are expected to speak on the occasion. The NSS also aims at developing the personality and character of the young students and to develop a national outlook among them. 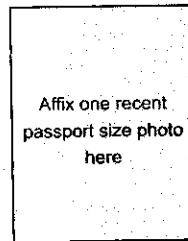
