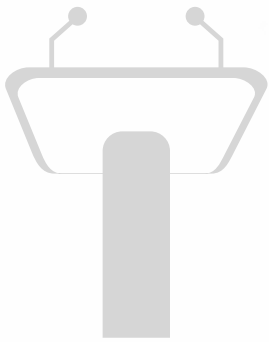

IMPACT

- All the resolutions passed at the annual national conclave are compiled as the 'Declaration' of the Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad and are submitted to the relevant policy making bodies of union and state governments. The relevant resolutions are also submitted to the United Nations and UNESCO for their cognizance.
- Participants are provided with the opportunity for a 10-day National Study Tour to Delhi, wherein they are exposed to various democratic institutions of national importance. Interactive sessions are held with constitutional authorities, political leaders and leaders from media sector.
- BCS also develops Entrepreneurial spirit - Conceptualize and establish one's own NGO or political party to transform specific areas in the Socio-Political arena.
- Based on the ideological affinity and interest, inclined, equipped and bright minds are sifted every year to undergo short term political leadership training program at the MIT School of Government. The BCS platform acts as a bridge between the Political Parties and Spirited Youth to provide sensitive and groomed leadership to the country.

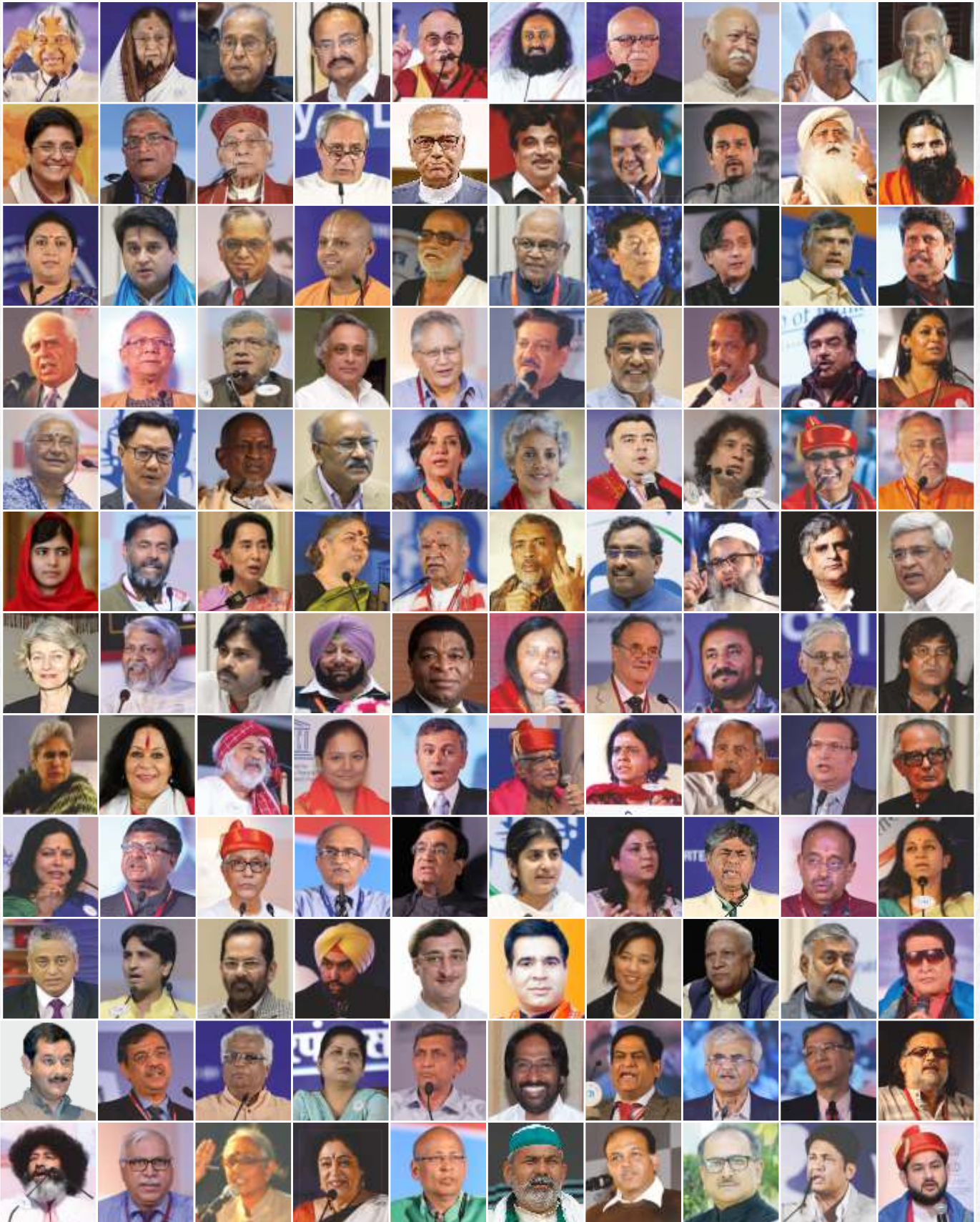

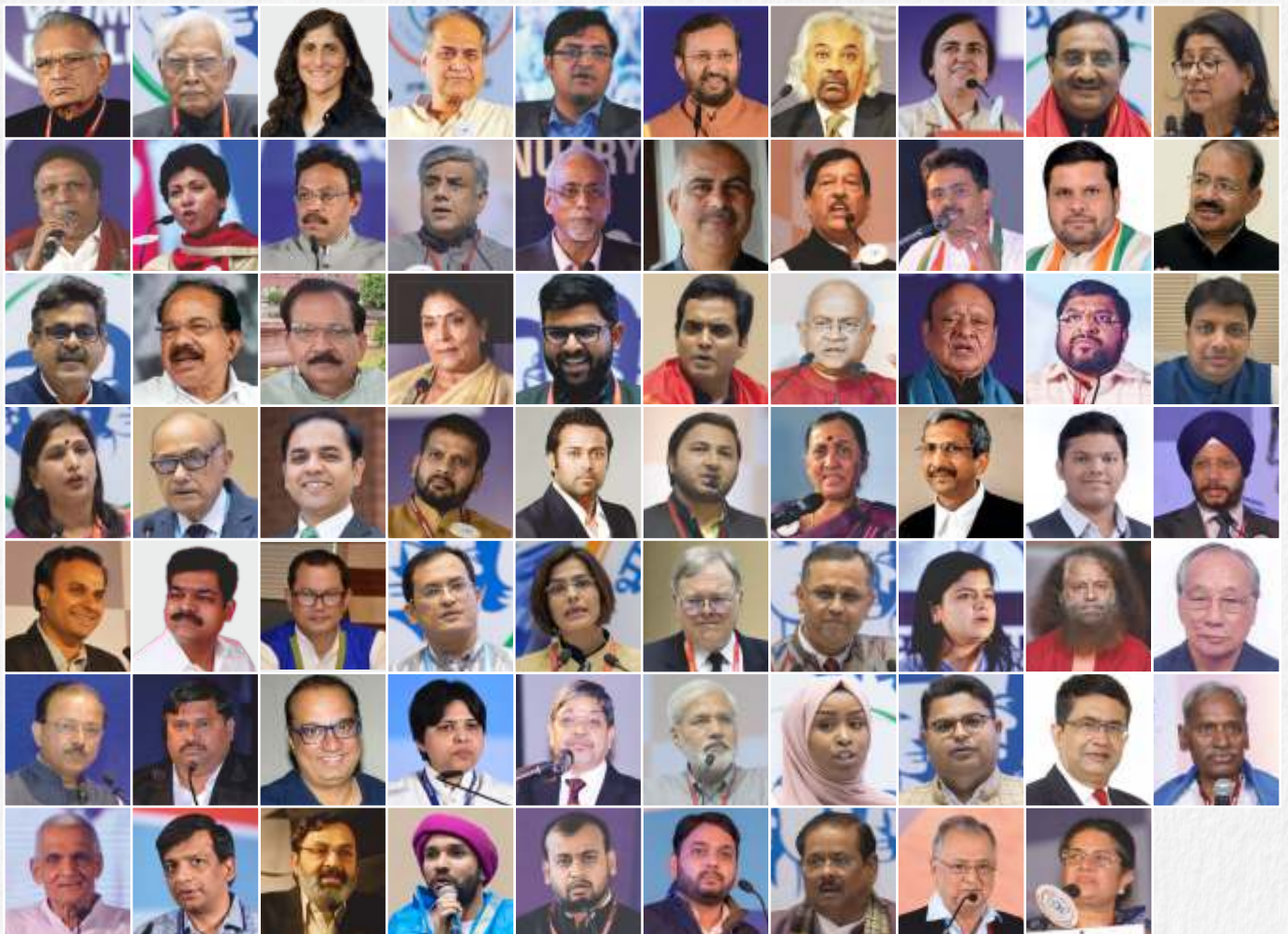
