Avishkar hosts a galaxy of events aimed at boosting the scientific, technological and management skills in today's youth, it provides them with an opportunity to showcase their fields of expertise. In the first stage the college level competition will be organized and the best entries would be selected for onward participation at District level, University level and Inter-University Competition. All the colleges are expected to participate in this competition aimed at providing a common platform to young and inquisitive minds.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

- To inculcate research culture among students.
- To encourage original and novel thing.
- To provide an opportunity for expression of academic talent
- To promote interaction among academic, R & D Institutes and Industries.

CATEGORIES FOR PARTICIPANT

- Humanities, Languages, Fine Arts etc.
- Commerce, Management, Law etc.
- Pure Sciences.
- Agriculture and Animal Husbandry.
- Medicine and Pharmacy.
- Engineering & Technology.

Each college/institution can sent separate entries for four levels of

- UG Level
- PG level
- Post PG Level(M.phil/ Ph. D)
- Teacher level

MODE OF SELECTION OF PROJECTS

STAGE-1: COLLEGE LEVEL COMPETITION

The colleges and institutions will conduct competitions at their level and shortlist two projects from each category for UG/PG, Research Students & Teachers Guiding Students level for participation at **STAGE – II**.

STAGE- II & III DISTRICT/ UNIVERSITY LEVEL COMPETITION

Short listed students from STAGE-I will be required to display and present their projects on 6th and 7th January, 2020 at **Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Arts, Commerce & science college, Chandrapur** of District level/ University Level for their selection to the University team.

The short listed candidates will have to submit their projects along with research papers and C.D.'s to the Director, Students' Welfare, Gondwana University for their evaluation by subject experts and final selection of University Team.

STAGE- IV

The selected team at STAGE- IV will be entitled to present their projects at Inter University Research Competition AVISHKAR- 2019 to be held at **University of Mumbai, Mumbai**. A workshop of the selected candidates for STAGE- III will be organized in mid of January 2017 to prepare the candidates for presentations at STAGE- IV level. At stage IV level only one candidate/entry will participate.

Guidelines to the Participants

1. Projects should be in the form of live demonstration/models/posters (1m x 1m size) and should bring out innovative and ideas in their respective categories.
2. The college/institution can send maximum two entries each at Under Graduate Level, Post Graduate Research Level (M. Phil/Ph. D.), Teachers Guiding Students in every category.
3. Participants are expected to display their projects before the panel of subject experts nominated by the authorities. The subject experts will shortlist the entries for oral presentations.
4. Shortlist projects will also have to give an oral presentation before the panel of subject experts.
5. Each oral presentation will be given 8 minutes followed by questions and answers for 2 minutes.
6. Each participating team shall not have more than two students engaged in the project.
7. Infrastructural facilities like working space, electricity, water, tables, mounting boards, LCD projector, overhead projector etc., will be made available to the participants by the organizing college/institution. For requirements other than the above mentioned facilities, participants should inform the coordinator well in advance.

8. All entries for STAGE- II should be forwarded through the Principal of the College/Head of Institution.
9. Registration is compulsory for all participants (Registration fee for STAGE- II : Rs. 100/- /entry/students)
10. Each participant will be given the participation certificate by the University.
11. Each decision of subject experts/judges will be final and binding on all participants.
12. All winning teams will be informed about their selection on the same day.

PROGRAMME SEHDULE

Registration

Day – I :

Inaugural Ceremony

Day – I : Poster :

Model display of research projects in the form of exhibition. This will be judged by the subject experts in the field. Experts will short list the candidates for oral presentations.

Day – II :

It is divided into two session, Pre-Lunch and Post-Lunch.


Pre-Lunch Session : Oral presentations strictly by students of selected/shortlisted research projects in each category.

Post-Lunch Session : Lectures by the eminent personalities in the field on various projects of research training in the relevant areas, followed by prize distribution ceremony.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

- The entries must be forwarded through Principal/Head of Institution.
- Maximum two entries in each category will be accepted for STAGE- II/III
- The participating team will have to register themselves at least FIVE days before the competition.

Inter disciplinary projects will also be accepted for presentation. However, the candidates must specify the category in which their project is to be placed.
