About Nagbhid :

Nagbhid is a town and a tehsil place in Chandrapur district of Maharashtra. It is 100 kilometers away from the district headquarter. By road, it is well connected with all places in Maharashtra and nearby states. The nearest railway station connected with all major cities in India and an international airport is in Nagpur which is at a distance of 90 kilometers from Nagbhid. The places of interest in and around the town are Tadoba Reserve Forest, Ghodezari lake, Indirasagar Dam (Gosikhurd National Project), Pandav Guphas and so on.

About Our Institution:

Few teachers of college from the adjoining Brahmapuri taluka founded the Janhit Shikshan Sanstha. They noticed that many students in the college where they taught did up-down from Nagbhid and surrounding villages as Nagbhid did not have higher education facility. That planted an idea in their mind about starting a higher education institution in Nagbhid.

The G.W. College was started in June 1986 offering B.A. and B.Com. programmes. With a number of innovative practices, the college soon achieved recognition as a major higher education institution in Chandrapur district. The college also started post graduation programmes in Marathi and Sociology. The college was first affiliated to Nagpur University, Nagpur and after the bifurcation of the university, it got affiliated to Gondwana University, Gadchiroli. The college has been included under 2(f)12(b) of UGC. The college has successfully completed three cycles of reaccreditations by NAAC, Bangalore. It was accredited with B grade in first two cycles and with B++ grade (2.91 CGPA) in the third cycle. The college has constantly augmented its infrastructure and added latest ICT tools for teaching learning. - Do not use footnotes.
- Word limit for each paper will be 2500 to 3000 words.

- The title of the paper should be in capital, center align 16pt followed by author (s), name(s), designation and institution's name in 12pt and right align. Works cited should be in alphabetical order.
- The contributors should email their full length papers with their payment details to sanjayrsingh2870@gmail.com, princ_gwcn@rediffmail.com, itsmedeepakmorande@rediffmail.com or nikita_rn291@rediffmail.com on or before 25 February 2020. Papers submitted without payment shall not be accepted.
- The responsibility of plagiarism will be of the authors.
