


THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE



The papers will undergo a Blind Review process and will be evaluated on different parameters such as originality, relevance, applicability and contribution to findings. **A soft copy of the full paper should be submitted only through the website.** Papers submitted through any other mode or after the due date will not be entertained. All correspondence will be addressed to the first author.
