
1. It is to inform you that only one Medical Examination will be held in each academic year as per ordinance.
2. The last date for submission of Medical Inspection reports of the students of your college separately for each class (i.e. 1st / 2nd / 3rd year) 31st December, 2016.
3. As such the Medical examination of students may be conducted preferably in the first term and the reports may be submitted on or before 31st December, 2016.
4. (A) The college which have not appointed their Medical Officer for Male & Female students are requested to appoint them immediately and communicate their name and qualification to the Registrar, Gondwana University, Gadchiroli for approval of the Executive Council with intimation of the same to this office.

(B) The appointment of Medical Officers should be in proportion to the number of students in the college. One Medical Officer may be appointed for every 300 students and may be appointed according to the availability in the following order :-
 1. M.B.B.S. of any statutory University who is registered or any Registered Medical Practitioner under the Indian Medical Council Act.
 2. B.A.M.S. of any statutory University.
 3. D.M.P. with three years Private Practice.
 4. B.H.M.S. Practice Holder.

- (C) The appointment of Medical Officers, may be done for a period of 3 to 5 years. If they are permanent resident of the same place and approval of the Executive Council of obtained to the subject.
5. Please let me know the number of Blank Forms that will be required for the Medical examination of students of your college separately for male and female students. It may please be noted that Blank forms are to be used for new entrants only. Old forms may be used for old students. The new forms are used every year for all students, hence the health record is not maintained. There are separate forms for male and female students. The big form is for the purpose of keeping the health record of the students through out his college career. The small form is given to the students (duly filled in and signed by Medical Officer) immediately after his examination for information and guidance of his parents. Hence the big form is required only for new students in the same college., his form should be used at each subsequent examinations. If this is done there will be monetary gain as well as it helps keeping the health record and serve the purpose of Medical Examination. Keeping this in view let me know your requirements for new forms separately for male and female students.
6. Forms will be supplied by this office on producing the receipt of the amount deposited in Account Section, Gondwana University, Gadchiroli. The charges of the Blank form will be @ 5/- (Five Rupees per set) of the form. Remuneration to the Doctor @ 4/-(Four Rupees) and @ 1/- (One Rupees) to the Medical Examination Organizer.
7. Please note that the amount of required Medical Examination form is to be deposited in account section in the Name of Finance & Account Officer Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
8. It is desired that defective cases may be 'Followed up' by the same Medical Officer's in the second Term (End of February 2017). As such it will be convenient if the Medical Examination is conducted in the First Terms.
