2. As per the specified provision of **Direction No. 17 of 2019 and 1 of 2020**, RAC is responsible / accountable to comply in accordance with State reservation policy. Henceforth Research Center Heads are advised to prepare the Roster Document in agreement with our State Reservation Policy in-force and forward the same in 2 copies to the University.
3. The Research Advisory committee (RAC) shall take care of the reservation policy of the State Government while allocating the supervisor/s to the inmate Ph. D. scholars and process their Ph. D. registration applications of the given subject as indicated below.

#### 4. Allocation of Seats:

The percentage of allocation of seats for various types of candidates i.e. for the Home University and University other than Home University shall be in accordance with the relevant provision of admission to Ph.D. program as specified in the concerned University Direction/Ordinance in-force.

- There shall be reservation of seats in each subject recognized at the given Research Center for the candidates belonging to the Home University as well as other than Home University candidates, subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time. This reservation shall be as per the following chart:-

#### NOTE:

- The above reservation is exclusive of the number of students belonging to the above categories who secure admission on merit.
- If any, of the Backward class categories mentioned above, do not get the required number of candidates for the percentage(s) laid down, the **seats so remaining vacant shall be filled-in from amongst the candidates belonging to the other reserved categories by way of inter-se merit round.**
- The valid Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the competent authorities is essential for all categories of reservation except SC and ST candidates as per Govt. Circular No. dated 15th June, 2006.
- Candidate claiming to, belong to the Backward Classes of the State must attach a certificate from the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate and the District Magistrate or the Executive Magistrate authorized by them in other areas, of Special Welfare



Officer of Zilla Parishad or Special Welfare Officer of Bombay. If no certificate is produced, it would be classified as Non-Backward.

- v. The admission of students from Reserved Category to the Ph.D. Program should be made on merit basis, based on the marks obtained by them in qualifying examination i.e. PET (Refer concerned Direction/Ordinance in-force).
- In addition to the above reservation there shall be further reservation of seats as mentioned below:-
  - vi. 5% seats will be reserved at each place of learning for the **person with disabilities** (P.W.D.) students as per the Right of Persons with Disabilities Acts 2016, Act No. 49 of 2016. The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the certificates strictly as per the prescribed Proforma.
  - vii. 5% seats will be reserved for **Ex-Serviceman/Military personnel** or their wards as per Govt. Resolution no. TCM 4204(167/85) MC, dated 13/06/1985 and University Letter No. GA/D/G/745 dated 07/02/1986.
  - viii. 10% seats shall be reserved for the **Economically Weaker Section** (EWS) of the people belonging to the open category per Govt. Resolution No. MISC-2019/Pra. Kra. 22/Vishi-3 dated 8<sup>th</sup> March'2019 and MISC-2019/Pra. Kra. 22/Vishi-3 dated 9<sup>th</sup> July'2019.
  - ix. 30% seats shall be reserved for the female candidates as per Govt. Resolution No. GEC-1000/(123/2000)/TE-1 dated 17<sup>th</sup> April'2000.




- For implementing reservation policy, it is directed that the reservation of the seats for reserved category candidates should be made according to the percentages prescribed for them on the basis of the total number of seats in the given subject.
  - Further, according to it, after all the seats as-on-date in the reserved categories according to their prescribed percentages are filled and thereafter if the post in any category becomes vacant due to **the submission of Ph. D. thesis** by the previously registered candidate, then it should be filled on fresh basis i.e. after all the 100 points of the roster are covered, a fresh cycle of 100 points shall start.
6. The RAC shall ensure recommendation of research scholar registration application of the Ph.D. program as per and in compliance with the para numbers 4 and 5 given above and forward the same to the University for tabling before RRC.
