3. Presenter will have 8 minutes to deliver the presentation.
4. More than one person can deliver the presentation.
5. Number of slides: 15 to 20 Slides
6. The presentation will be judged by a panel of judges. The following will be the distribution of marks for the presentation.
  - Content of the presentation - 10 marks
  - Confidence & Verbal Skill - 10 marks
  - Use of the graphics, sound & Videos - 10 marks
  - Colour Scheme & Background - 10 marks
  - Question round - 10 marks
  - No plagiarism. The power point Presentation should be the original work of the students.
  - All the participants will be awarded participation certificate.
7. Inform the organizers if you have any special presentation requirements other than PowerPoint such as computer audio, etc.
8. Arrive well before your time-slot to ensure that your presentation is correctly loaded on to the computer.
9. Failure to turn- up at your allocated time-slot will be interpreted as a withdrawal from the competition.
10. The judge's decision'll be final and binding upon the participants.

## Poster Presentation Rules

2. The poster presentation should be 24" in length X 36" in width.

  - The poster should be wrapped neatly
3. The name of the participant should not be written on the poster. Be sure to bring pushpins & thumbtacks to mount your poster. They will not be provided to you at the venue.
