- The abstract and full paper should be submitted on or before 31* December, 2016 to icon@kristujayanti.com
- Receipt of all papers would be acknowledged but only accepted papers would be specifically mentioned as 'Accepted' before 5th January, 2017
- The completed registration form along with registration fee should reach the conference secretariat on or before 14th January, 2017 once the acceptance of the paper is intimated
