

ORDINANCE NO. 113 of 2017.

EXAMINATIONS LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF LAWS (B.A.L.L.B.) (TEN SEMESTER DEGREE COURSE) BASED ON CREDIT SYSTEM IN THE FACULTY OF HUMANITIES ORDINANCE, 2017.

Whereas, it is expedient to provide an ordinance in respect of Examinations leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) (Ten semester Degree Course) based on Choice based credit system in the faculty of Humanities, Ordinance, 2017 for the purposes hereinafter appearing, the Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following Ordinance :-

1. This Ordinance shall be called “Examinations leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) (Ten semester Degree Course) based on Choice based credit system in the faculty of Humanities, Ordinance, 2017.”
2. This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the date of its making by the Management Council.
3. Duration of the Programme: The duration of the programme shall be 5 academic years which spread over 10 semesters with the University Examination at the end of each Semester.

Each Academic Year shall be divided into Two semesters. The academic year for Odd semesters (1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th & 9th) will commence as far as possible from 1st of July, while Even Semester (2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th & 10th) will commence from 1st of January every year.

An examination for each of the semester shall be held twice in a year at such places and on such dates as may be fixed by the University. The fees for the examination shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time.

4. Unless the context otherwise requires, the following words shall have the meaning as assigned to them in this Ordinance.
 - (a) Academic Year: Two consecutive (one odd + one even) semesters constitute one academic year.
 - (b) ATKT: means Allowed to Keep Term in Higher Semester as per the provisions of this Ordinance.
