



GONDWANA UNIVERSITY, GADCHIROLI

Direction No. 3 of 2023

“Maximum And minimum intake of students for admission to the academic programmes leading to the award of certificate, Diploma, Bachelor’s Degree, Post- Graduate Diploma or Post Graduate Degree in affiliated colleges/institutions of the University, Direction, 2023”.

Whereas, the Maharashtra Public University Act 2016(Mah. Act VI of 2017)(hereinafter the “Act”)has come into force with effect from, 1st March, 2017 and the same has been made applicable to the Gondwana University, Gadchiroli (hereinafter the “University”);

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council of the University is the competent authority to grant affiliation to the newly established college/institution or newly started courses of studies, subjects, faculties, additional divisions or satellite centres in the existing college/institutions and the Academic Council also has the power to prescribe the number of students to be admitted by the affiliated college/institution for its academic programmes under section 110 of the Act;

AND

Whereas, the Academic Council of the University has the powers to make Ordinances and Regulations with respect to the academic matters and prescription of maximum and minimum number of students for any academic programme offered by any affiliated college/institution is undoubtedly an academic matter it follows that the subject of prescription of the maximum and minimum intake of students [programme-wise] by affiliated colleges/institutions requires making of an Ordinance/framing of Regulations by the Academic Council;

AND

Whereas, making of an Ordinance being a time consuming process the University had issued Direction No. 18 of 2019 entitled “Maximum or Minimum Intake for Admission to the Courses Leading to the Certificate or Diploma or Bachelor Degree or Post Graduate

Diploma or Post Graduate Degree at the Affiliated Colleges of the University, Direction, 2019” under the provisions of sub-section (8) of section 12 of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016;

AND

Whereas, by virtue of the provisions of the proviso to section 12[8] of the Act the Direction No. 18 of 2019 has lapsed on the expiry of the period of six months from the date of issuance of the said Direction as it could not be converted in to the necessary Ordinance, necessitating issuance of a fresh Direction, incorporating the provisions of the said lapsed Direction No. 18 of 2019 with suitable modifications;


Now, therefore, I Dr. Prashant S. Bokare, Vice- Chancellor, Gondwana University, Gadchiroli in exercise of the powers vested in me under the provision of Section 12(8) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016, do hereby issue the following Direction: -

1. This Direction may be called **“Maximum And minimum intake of students for admission to the academic programmes leading to the award of certificate, Diploma, Bachelor’s Degree, Post- Graduate Diploma or Post Graduate Degree in affiliated colleges/institutions of the University, Direction, 2023”**.
2. This Direction shall come into force with effect from the date of its issuance.
3. This Direction shall apply to admission of students in the affiliated colleges and institutions and also the recognised institutions of the University.
4. In this Direction, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - a) “Act” means the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016.
 - b) “Affiliated college” means a college/Institution which has been granted affiliation and or continuation of affiliation by the University in terms of the provisions of the Act.
 - c] “Programme” means an academic programme of one or more years or semesters and comprising various courses successful completion of which leads to award of any Certificate, Diploma, Bachelor’s Degree, Post Graduate-Diploma or Post Graduate Degree by the University.
 - d] “University” means Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
4. Subject to the permission, decision, order, resolution of the state government prescribing or permitting maximum intake capacity of students for any programme otherwise than what is prescribed in this Direction, the maximum intake of students for admission in each initial year or each initial semester or each section of the corresponding year of the programmes leading to the award of any certificate,

Diploma, Bachelor's Degree, Post Graduate-Diploma, and Post Graduate Degree in affiliated colleges/ Institution of the University shall be as shown in Column No. 3 of the Table in Appendix- A of this Direction.

5. The minimum intake for admission in each initial year or each initial semester of the program leading to the award of Certificate, Diploma, Bachelor' Degree, Post-Graduate Diploma and Post Graduate Degree at affiliated colleges/ Institution in the University shall be as per the ratio prescribed in Column No. 4 of the Table given in Appendix-B of this Direction.
6. The condition of maximum/minimum intake capacity for admission will be applicable to a newly started programme if permission for starting the same is granted by the state government on or before 15th June of the year under consideration.
7. The maximum/minimum intake for the programme not included in Appendix A of this Direction shall be as decided by the Academic Council of the University.
8. Where the requirement of maximum/minimum intake capacity prescribed hereunder is not fulfilled for any three consecutive years, after starting of the programmes, the University shall initiate action to de-affiliate the given programmes as per the procedure prescribed for the same. Where, however the requirement of minimum intake could not be fulfilled for unprecedented reasons, the same shall be taken into consideration by the Academic Council.
9. The conditions of minimum or maximum intake capacity, prescribed herein shall not be applicable to the programmes for which admission are done through the centralised admission process operated by the authority appointed by the state government or any other authority. It also will not be applicable to the innovative professional programmes, minimum competency programmes, skill oriented programmes and demand based programmes permitted by the state or central government.
