



## GONDWANA UNIVERSITY GADCHIROLI

### **Ordinance No. 43 of 2017.**

#### **Examination leading to the degree of Master of Library and information Science ( I year course) in the faculty of Social Sciences, Ordinance, 2017.**

**Whereas**, it is expedient to provide an Ordinance in respect of Examination leading to the Degree of **Master of Library and information Science**, ( One year course) in the faculty of Social Sciences, for the purposes hereinafter appearing, the Management council is hereby pleased to make the following ordinance :-

Whereas The Maharashtra Universities Act. No.XXXV of 1994 (hereinafter referred as the Act) has July, 1994 and has amended from time to time,

**And**

Whereas the board of studies in Library and Information Science in its meeting held on 18.04.2012 at Gondwana University, Gadchiroli has resolved to introduce the Master of Library and Information Science 1 years post graduate degree course recommended for continuation

**And**

Whereas the board of studies in Library and Information Science has prepared the syllabi for the Master of Library and Information Science examination and recommended for its implication from the academic session 2012-13 progressively.

**And**

Whereas the Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences concurred with the recommendation of the Board of Studies in Library and Information Science on 09.05.2012 and requested to the Vice-Chancellor to take appropriate action for implementation of the same from the academic session 2012-13,

**And**

Whereas the Vice-Chancellor of Gondwana University, Gadchiroli approved the recommendations of the Board of Studies in Library and Information Science concurred by the Dean, Faculty of Social Science, for Master of Library and Information Science two years post graduate degree course on **Credit Based Semester Pattern** in four semester on behalf of the Academic Council and Management council under section 14(7) of the act and syllabi for the same under section 38(a) of the Act on 21 July 1994 and amended from time to time,

**And**

Whereas the process prescribed for making ordinance is time consuming

1. This ordinance may be called “Examinations leading to the degree of Master of Library and information science (One year course), in the faculty

of social sciences.

2. This ordinance shall come into force with effect from the date of its making by the Management council.
3. The duration of Library and Information Science Master degree course will be one year and there will be university examination at the end of academic session.
4. Subject to his compliance with the provisions of this ordinance and of any other ordinances in force from time to time an applicant for admission to:

**M. Lib.I.Sc. - Examination shall :**

- i) Have been admitted to the bachelor's degree of any statutory university or any other degree recognized as equivalent thereto.
  - ii) Have since passing the examination of the bachelor's Degree prosecuted a regular course for not less than one Academic year in the university Department of Library and Information Science or any other institution affiliated to the university for the purpose.
5. The examination leading to the Master degree of library and information sciences shall be held in a year at such places and on such dates as may fixed by the university.
  6. The examination fee shall be as prescribed by the university from time to time.
  7. The scope of subjects shall be as indicated in the syllabus pattern of question paper on the unit system shall be as shown in Appendix- A.
  8. The number of papers/practical and the maximum marks assigned to each papers/practical and the maximum marks an examinee must obtain in order to pass the examinations shall be as indicated in appendix – B appended with this ordinance.
  9. Every student after completion Bachelor of Library and information science examination shall be required to undergo a course of practical library work for a period of not less than thirty working days (30) in any of libraries of affiliated colleges/ institutions recognized by the university and the degree shall be awarded only on submission of a certificated of satisfactory completion of the practical library work from the librarian of the concerned institution/college.
  10. An examinee that either does not pass or fail to present himself the examination shall be eligible to appear at any subsequent examination without prosecuting a regular course study.
  11. An examinee failing the examination but obtaining not less than 40% of the marks in theory part of the subject shall be exempted from appearing at subsequent examination in that subject.
    - i) Examinee securing 50% or more marks in practical part of the examination

shall be exempted from appearing in that part at a subsequent examination.

ii) An examinee passing the examination as a whole in the minimum, prescribed period and obtaining the prescribed number of places in the first or second division shall be arranged in order of merit.

12. The examinee who are successful in the bachelor of Library and Information science examination and have obtain 60% or more marks in the aggregate of the B.Lib.I.Sc. examination shall be placed in the first division, those obtaining less than 60% but not less than 50% shall be placed in the second division.
13. Provisions of ordinance award of grace marks for passing an examination, securing higher division/class and for securing distinction in the subject (s) shall apply to the examination.
14. Notwithstanding anything contrary in this ordinance, no persons shall be admitted to this examination, if he has already passed the same from this university or of any other statutory university.
15. Examinee's successful at the final examination shall on payment of the prescribed fees, be entitled for the award of the degree in the prescribed form signed by the Vice-Chancellor.

### **(Statement of object and reasons)**

The Vice-chancellor of the university had issued Direction No. 142 of 2012 on 26/6/2012 in respect of Direction governing the examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Library and Information Science (One year course) in the faculty of social sciences, under provision of section 14 (8) of the Maharashtra university Act, 1994.

The subject matter of the Direction is required to be regulated by an ordinance as provided under the Act.

In view of the above, the existing Direction is required to be converted into an ordinance as provided under the Act, hence this Draft ordinance is prepared for consideration of the Academic council and the Management council.

**The pattern of question paper as per unit system**

The pattern of question paper as per unit system will be broadly based on the following pattern :

The syllabus has been divided into units equal to the no. of question to be answered in the paper. The students will have to solve all six questions as per the close given. On each unit there will be two questions a long answer type with an internal choice and the students will have to solve any one.

Five questions will be carried equal 12 marks and sixth question will be carried 20 marks. The type of sixth question is short answered type and will be comprises of all units.

The student will have to solve 4 short answers out of 6 in sixth question and each short question carried five marks.
