Ordinance NO. 54 OF 2017.

Addition of Incentive marks for National Service Scheme, Adult and Continuing Education and Extension Services, National Cadet Corps, Games & Sports and Cultural Activities. To examination evaluation of the collegiate students, Ordinance 2017.

Whereas, it is expedient to provide ordinance in respect of “ Addition of incentive marks for National Service scheme Adult and continuing education and extension services, National cadet corps Games & Sports and Cultural activities, to examination evaluation of the collegiate students” for the purposes hereinafter appearing, The Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following Ordinance :-

1. This Ordinance may be called “ Addition of Incentive Marks, for National Services Scheme, Adult & Continuing Education & extension Services, National Cadet Corps, Games & Sports and Cultural Activities, to examination evaluations of the collegiate student ordinance, 2017.”
2. This Ordinance shall come into force from the date of its making by the Management Council.
3. **Scope:** This Ordinance shall apply to all the students of all the Faculties admitted & enrolled in a college conducted by the Gondwana University Gadchiroli and also affiliated to Gondwana University Gadchiroli./ University Post Graduate Departments
4. In this Ordinance unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - i. “Act” means Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994.
 - ii. “College” means a College conducted by the Gondwana University, Gadchiroli or affiliated to the Gondwana University, Gadchiroli conducting U.G./P.G. Degree Courses.
 - iii. “Zone” means zones as defined by “Association of Indian Universities.
 - iv. “Principal” means a Head of the College duly approved by the Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
 - v. “Student” means a student admitted in a college/Post Graduate Department
 - vi. “Controller of Examinations” means the controller of Examinations appointed under Section 18 of the Act.
 - vii. Departments means the Departments of the University conducting Post Graduate Degree Courses.
5. Maximum 25 (Twenty Five) Marks as an Incentive as shown in the Para - 10 below shall be granted to the student appearing for Gondwana University Examinations for any Degree, for his/her participation in any one of the following programmes conducted by a college Department under Gondwana University, Gadchiroli:
 - (A) National Service Scheme (N.S.S.)
 - (B) Adult and Continuing Education & Extension Services (A.C.E.E.S.)

- (C) National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.)
- (D) Games & Sports.
- (E) Cultural Activities.

Provided that if a student participates in more than one activity, he/she shall be granted the marks only in that activity in which he/she has secured the maximum marks of all the programmes listed above.

6. Guidelines for Processing of Examination result and Estimation of SGPA under the adapted Credit Grade System:

- (1) The incentive credit marks secured by the participating students shall be awarded Grades which shall be reflected in a separate column in the Transcript/Grade-sheet of the respective examination.
- (2) The awarded grade shall be converted to Grade Points (GP) as per the table given below and that the 'Credit' associated shall be 'Zero'.
- (3) The Grade Points thus arrived at, shall be added to grade point value (GPV) of all the heads of passing of the given semester examination considered in the numerator of SGPA formula.
- (4) However, for the purpose of estimation of SGPA, the credit associated shall be taken as 'One' which will not be added to the total credits of that semester considered in the denominator of SGPA formula.
- (5) The students' performance in the aforesaid examination shall be evaluated based on relevant provisions of ordinance relating to the Processing of the Examination Results.
- (6) Further that the estimated SGPA thus, shall be counted for calculation of CGPA, being basis for the award of the Degree, merit ranks, if any, awards, medals, scholarship and prizes as well.

7. The incentive marks in the form of Grades and relative Grade Points shall be granted to the student only for that examination during the course of which the student has participated in the programme mentioned in Para 5 above.

8. Student shall be eligible to get maximum 25 incentive marks for participation in only one of the programmes listed under Para 5 above.
9. For Degree/ Post Graduate Degree level courses without 'Model Credit Grade System', the incentive marks awarded to the student as per Para 10 given below, should be added to the total marks of the University examination in which the candidate has appeared.
10. The incentive marks shall be granted to the student on the basis of his/her participation in any one of the programmes as given below:

- (A) National Service Scheme (N.S.S.)** 10 Marks
- i. Participation in regular N.S.S. Programme,
(Minimum 120 hours in 3 Years) 3 Marks
 - ii. Participation in N.S.S. , and
(7 days Camp at college level) 3 Marks
 - iii. Participation in University or State
or National Level camp. 4 Marks

(B) Adult & Continuing Education & Extension Services :-

i. Adult Education (Literacy)

Student enrolled in the literacy campaign as literacy volunteer under the Department of Adult and Continuing Education & Extension Services, Gondwana University and made literate atleast 5 illiterate persons in a year. In the case, 2 marks per illiterate person made literate shall be awarded subject to a maximum of 10 marks,

OR

ii. Continuing Education (Post Literacy)

Student participated in the post literacy programme under the Department of Adult and Continuing Education & Extension Services, Gondwana University and made post literate atleast 10 neoliterates. In the case, one mark per neoliterated person made post literate shall be awarded subject to a maximum of 10 marks,

OR

iii. Population Education

Student enrolled in population club at college level and successfully participated in any two project/s undertaken by the college through its population Education Club under the Department of Adult Education & Continuing Education and Extension Services,

10 Marks

(C) National Cadet Corps (NCC) :-

- i. Participation in N.C.C. in a year and attended more than 75% parades; 2 Marks
- ii. Passing 'C' certificate Examination; 2 Marks
- iii. Participation in Annual Training ; 2 Marks
- iv. Participation in Republic Day Parade; at National Level, and 2 Marks
- v. Holder of rank not below the Rank of Sergeant or an equivalent Distinction achieved by the Cadet. 2 Marks

(D) Games and Sports

- i. Participation of Students in Inter-Collegiate Competition organized by Gondwana University; 10 Marks
- ii. First, second, & Third position obtained in Inter-Collegiate competitions organized by Gondwana University; and 15 Marks
- iii. Participation in Inter-University competition State or National level organized by the Sports Association/Organization/Association of Indian Universities.

OR

- iv. Participation in Inter-National Competition organized by the Sports Association/Organization/World University Body 25 Marks
- Note that the Students shall be eligible for maximum credit marks in any one of the level singularly.

(E) Cultural Activities

- i. Participation in Inter Collegiate Cultural Activities like Debate Drama, Music, Fine Arts, Theater Dance, Literacy organised by Gondwana University; 3 Marks
- ii. Participation in cultural Activities at Inter-University/ Zonal level; and 3 Marks
- iii. Participation in Inter University Cultural Activities at State/National level. 4 Marks

11. (a) The Principal of the College/ Head of the Department shall submit detailed information about the participation of students in the activities mentioned in Para - 5 of this Ordinance for the grant of credit marks to the participating students to the concerned authorities as mentioned below, in the proforma prescribed by them on or before 15th March of every year:

- (b) Information received after the due date shall not be accepted by the concerned officers.
- (c) The concerned officers shall submit their report along with the marks allotted to each student, after their verification, to the Controller of Examinations, Gondwana University in the proforma prescribed by him before the commencement of the concerned Examinations.

(Statement of object and reasons)

The Vice – Chancellor of the University on 27/06/2013 had issued Direction No. 161 of 2013 under provision of sub-section (8) of section 14 of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 in respect of “ Addition of incentive marks for National Service Scheme, adult and continuing education and extension Services, National cadet corps, Games & sports and cultured activities, to examination evaluation of the collegiate students”

The above said Direction is required to be converted into an ordinance, hence this Draft ordinance is prepared for consideration of the Academic Council and the Management Council of the University.
