DIRECTION PRESCRIBING AWARD OF THE UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL DEGREE COURSES OFFERED BY THE UNIVERSITY BASED ON CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE(CGPA) (AMENDMENT) DIRECTION, 2016.

Whereas, Direction No. 177 of 2015 is issued by the Vice-Chancellor under provision of section 14(8) of the Maharashtra universities Act,1994 for prescribing award of the under graduate level degree Courses offered by the university based on cumulative grade point average(CGPA);

AND

Whereas, various ten point scales are presently mentioned in the Direction No. 177 of 2015 for B.A.LL.B.(5 years); B.A.LL.B.(Honours), B.E., B.Pharm. Also, different scales are used for theory and Laboratory, it is difficult to implement different scales for theory and practicals;

AND

Whereas, different tables calculated marks differently, for various courses;

AND

Whereas, it is necessary on this background to have uniform conversion formulae;

Now, therefore, I, Dr.N.V. Kalyankar. Vice-Chancellor Gondwana University, Gadchiroli in exercise of the powers vested in me under provision of sub-section(8) of section 14 of the Maharashtra universities Act,1994 do hereby issue following Directions to amend the provision made under Direction No.177 of 2015:-

- 1)This Direction may be called “Direction prescribing award of the under graduate level degree courses offered by the university based on cumulative grade point average(CGPA)(Amendment) Direction,2016.”

2) This direction shall come into force with effect from the date of its issuance.

3) At the bottom of the Table No.5, appearing under para. 7 of Direction No. 177 of 2015 regarding Direction prescribing award of the undergraduate level degree courses offered by the university based on cumulative grade point average(CGPA)', the following matter, table and note be added.

“The conversion formulae for CGPA to percentage for six point scale and ten point scale shall be as given in the following table.

Table

Sr. No.	Scale	CGPA Range	Formula
1	Six point scale	1 to 4	$P = 6.8 \times \text{CGPA} + 29.8$
		4 to 6	$P = 5.25 \times (\text{CGPA})^2 - 37.25 \times \text{CGPA} + 122$
2	Ten Point Scale	1 to 10	$P = (\text{CGPA} - 0.75) \times 100 / 10$

Note:- The Note as “CGPA to percentage conversion formulae are printed over leaf” be printed on front side of the statement of marks and the formulae be printed on back side of the said statement of marks.”
